<b>PACE</b>	Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly
<b>PASRR</b>	Preadmission Screening and Resident Review
<b>PCP</b>	Person-Centered Planning
<b>PERS</b>	Personal Emergency Response System
<b>RC</b>	Related Condition (often known as DD or developmental disability)
<b>RR</b>	Resident Review
<b>R/S</b>	Referral Source

<b>SC</b>	Status Change

GLOSSARY	
Term	Definition
<b>Screen</b>	A Level I or Level of Care assessment
<b>Admitting Facility</b>	The identified nursing facility to which the person intends to be admitted
<b>Clinical User</b>	Staff person with clinical knowledge and understanding who can both complete and submit the screen to MAXIMUS
<b>Community Placement</b>	Any housing situation aside from hospital or nursing facility—this includes, but is not limited to, Assisted Living Facilities, Hospice, group homes, independent living homes, and senior communities
<b>Dual Diagnosis</b>	Mental Illness <i>and</i> Intellectual Disability/Related Condition
<b>Executive Contact</b>	Person responsible for signing the AP Administrator agreement—this is a supervisor or other senior management officer who attests the AP Admin has authority to submit screens on behalf of the facility/agency they are representing
<b>Legal Guardian</b>	The person or entity who is court appointed and legally responsible for decision making on behalf of an individual.
<b>Level I</b>	PASRR screening tool for persons admitting to Medicaid certified NFs, who have or may have a Serious Mental Illness (SMI), intellectual/Developmental Disability (ID/DD), or Related Condition (RC)



INDIANA PASRR  
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<b>Level II</b>	In depth PASRR evaluation for persons with a Serious Mental Illness (SMI), intellectual/Developmental Disability (ID/DD), or Related Condition (RC)
<b>Non Clinical User</b>	Staff person with no or limited clinical knowledge of the person who can enter information into a screen yet cannot submit the screen—only clinical users may submit screens in AssessmentPro
<b>PASRR</b>	Preadmission Screening and Resident Review
<b>Provider</b>	Health care provider or agency providing medical care or services
<b>Queued for Review</b>	Indicates a Level I and/or Level of Care have been submitted in AssessmentPro and the information provided requires a nurse to review the content prior to receiving an outcome determination
<b>Referral Source</b>	The person/facility/agency who submitted the Level I and/or Level of Care screen
<b>Specialized Services</b>	Intensive services exceeding those which can be provided by NF staff or rehabilitative services
<b>Targeted Resident Review</b>	A RR that is targeted for a subsequent review or quality check because certain markers are present (e.g. history of recidivism, aggression, etc.)
